**Carroll County Planning Commission**

**Minutes**

- I. Call to Order. Chairman Doyal called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
- II. Roll Call. The County Planner called the roll. Present: Chairman Jerry Doyal, Commissioners Randy Coggins, Kim Hagen, Cassie Marshall, and Terry Agne. Commissioner Deiadre Wilson was absent.
- III. Minutes (January 22, 2019). Unanimously adopted on a Motion by Commissioner Coggins, seconded by Commissioner Hagen.
- IV. Business Session. There was no business.
- V. Hearing Procedures: Chairman Doyal reviewed the hearing procedures, copies of which are available and made part of the Minutes by reference.
- VI. Requests:  
  
C-19-03-01: Conditional Use for a Cell Tower. Land Lot 231 of the 11<sup>th</sup> District, Parcel #049-0051, located at 171 Lolly Bump Road. Owner: Ronnie Musick. Applicant: Verizon Wireless. Commission District 6.  
  
David Kirk, attorney for Verizon Wireless, spoke on behalf of the application. He stated that there was a need to provide for better coverage in the area of the proposed tower. He stated that it would be 230 feet with a 10 foot lightning rod on top. He stated that it would be able to accommodate additional carriers.  
  
Commissioner Doyle asked if airports were notified of this application. Mr. Kirk responded that indeed they had, by virtue of an “FAA determination of no hazard” that is included in the paperwork submitted.  
  
Mr. Kirk went on to state that the tower would have lighting in both day and night to alert aircraft, but that it would be situated so as to not interfere with residents on the ground.  
  
There were no other questions. Commissioner Marshall made the motion to approve and Commissioner Coggins seconded. The vote to recommend approval was unanimous.  
  
There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
