CALL TO ORDER, INVOCATION, AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Morgan called the December 6, 2022 Board of Commissioners meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Richard Harrison of the Sheriff's Department offered the Invocation, and Commissioner Chamber led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

9. XVI. Subdivision Ordinance


On a Motion by Commissioner McClendon and seconded by Commissioner Fuller, the Commission voted 4 (in favor)-3 (opposed: Commissioner Reynolds, Commissioner Lee, and Commissioner Chance opposed) to approve the proposed amendments to the Subdivision Regulations of Carroll County, Georgia, as amended: (1) to amend Section 86-5. “Definitions” of Chapter 86 – Subdivisions, to amend the definition of “Subdivision exemptions;” (2) to allow for Estate Lot Developments; (3) to provide for other exemptions to the Subdivision Regulations; and (4) for other purposes.

12. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:26 p.m. on a motion by Commissioner Chance and a second by Commissioner McClendon, which was unanimously approved.
