On a motion by Commissioner Chance and seconded by Commissioner McClendon, the Commission voted 6-0 to approve a reduction of the Millage Rate to 7.58 mills in the unincorporated area of Carroll County and adopt the proposed Resolution that provides for Homestead Exemptions for the residents in the County and includes a reduction in the City of Carrollton and the City of Bremen for duplication of services for fire protection (Carrollton at 6.20 mills; and for Bremen at 6.20 mills).
