**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on Tuesday, March 20, 2018, a Special Election will be held in the regular polling places for Carroll County Commission District 1.

This election will be held to fill the unexpired term of Trent North, Commission Member, District 1, who resigned effective December 31, 2017. The unexpired term for District 1 will end December 31, 2020.

Non-partisan qualifying for said election will be conducted in the Offices of the Carroll County Election Supervisor. Qualifying will take place from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Monday, January 22 and Tuesday, January 23, and from 8:30 a.m. until 12 noon on Wednesday, January 24.

The qualifying fee for District Commissioner District 1 will be \$ 204.96.

All candidates must be at least 21 years of age, a registered voter, a resident of Carroll County for a period of twelve months prior to the date of the election, and a resident of the district at the time of qualifying. Any person convicted of a felony involving moral turpitude shall not be eligible, unless all rights have been restored by a pardon of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles.

The last day to register and be eligible to vote in this election will be February 20, 2018. The election shall be held on Tuesday, March 20, 2018, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Advanced In-Person voting is 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Monday, February 26, 2018 – Friday, March 16, 2018 at the Carroll County Elections and Registration Office. If there is a need for a runoff election, the date of the Election will be April 17, 2018.

All duly qualified electors of Carroll County, Commission District 1 are urged to participate. Those qualified to vote at said election shall be determined in all respects in accordance and conformity with the laws of the State of Georgia.

Local candidates will be provided basic information regarding these forms at the time of qualifying however it is the responsibility of the candidate or elected official to file all mandatory reports. Reports are filed with the Carroll County Elections Office. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §21-2-72 all qualifying forms and reports are open to the public.
